BIDDER NOTICE: There are still several outstanding questions submitted by proposers that are unanswered in this addendum. JGL and BCC are working on compiling their respective answers and will issue a second addendum as soon as possible. Thank you for your patience.

On August 29th, 2022, Bergen Community College (BCC) held a pre-proposal conference in connection to its current RFP# R-097 Management and Operation of Food Services. BCC and the College's consultants received questions from interested proposers both during the pre-proposal conference and for a time period following the conference until 5pm September 9th, 2022. Below is the College's addendum which responds to all questions asked during the time frame. Please note that BCC only responded to questions that were correctly submitted as outlined in Section 1.4 of RFP# R-097. Please incorporate these responses into your proposals accordingly.

Answers to questions posed:

General

1. Q: Can bidders visit the Lyndhurst and Hackensack campuses? Can bidders request follow-up tours of various BCC spaces?

A: Yes, bidders can visit the Lyndhurst and Hackensack campuses as well as request follow-up tours of specific BCC spaces. Please contact purchasing@bergen.edu for such requests; BCC will coordinate all such visits as quickly as possible.

2. Q: Can BCC provide CAD drawings for the various spaces?

A: BCC is unable to share any CAD drawings of foodservice spaces. Bidders should utilize the information provided in the RFP to the greatest extent possible, particularly with regards to any conceptual renderings or equipment layouts.

3. What will be the turn-around time for any necessary renovations, new concepts, and repair of any equipment should a transition occur?

A: Once contract award has been made, the incoming Operator may immediately begin planning its transition into the space with an eye towards minimizing extensive on-site presence until the end of the Fall 2022 semester. Following the end of the semester, the incoming Operator will be able to access the facilities in order to undertake any necessary repairs, renovations, and station re-concepting in preparation for the beginning of the Spring 2023 semester. As for more extensive renovations, BCC would work with the selected Operator to identify a lengthier period of time when such work could take place.

4. Q: What is the status of the current POS system? How old is it/is it owned by the current Operator?

A: The InfoPOS system is owned by the current Operator and will be removed in the case of a transition. Regardless, the system is quite outdated and any incoming Operator would benefit from transitioning to a more modern system.

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5. Is it possible to outsource equipment maintenance to third-party contractors, or must it be done by the Selected Operator?

A: The Selected Operator is allowed to appoint third-party contractors to conduct equipment maintenance provided they hold the proper insurance requirements as outlined in the RFP. BCC must be notified in advance of any such arrangement.

6. Q: Is BCC open to creating a foodservice committee with the Selected Operator?

A: BCC is absolutely interested in having ongoing dialogue with its selected Operator for the duration of the term. This can take the form of monthly committee meetings, quarterly business reviews, student/faculty open houses, etc. The frequency and scope of these meetings will be determined in cooperation with the Selected Operator.

Contractual

1. Q: Given the potential cost of renovations for the 2nd Floor Café, would the College be willing to look at a 10-year term option?

A: As a general rule of thumb, the College is not considering a 10-year contract at this time. However, BCC is aware of the potentially large investment needed for a renovation of the 2nd Floor Café. Depending on the scope, concept, and scale of proposed renovations, BCC may be willing to entertain a five-year option with one five-year renewal. Bidders should still propose 3- and 5- year term options regardless. Please make sure to clearly differentiate any investment or financial offers between the various term offers.

2. Q: Did BCC exercise an early termination right with its current Operator or has the contract term expired?

A: BCC did not exercise any early termination right with its current Operator. The current contract will expire prior to the Selected Operator transitioning into BCC.

3. Q: Does the current Operator own all franchise licenses? Are any of the licenses transferrable should a transition take place?

A: Yes, the current Operator owns both the Dunkin' Donuts and Subway franchise licenses. The licenses aren't transferrable but an incoming Operator could easily apply for a license of their own.

4. Q: Does the current Operator pay a percentage of sales as franchise fees?

A: The Operator does pay license fees on both the Dunkin' Donuts and Subway franchises. The fees are negotiated by the licensor and the current Operator; therefore, any licensing agreement if a transition were to occur would need to negotiate entirely new fee structures.

Staffing

1. Q: Is the current Operator's hourly staff union? If so, can you provide the CBA, seniority list, and wages, hours, and benefits?

A: The current Operator's staff does have a collective bargaining agreement in place with IBEW Local 1158. BCC is not party to the collective bargaining agreement; thus, the College is not able to share this information. Bidders are encouraged to reach out directly to IBEW Local 1158 directly for such information.

2. Q: Can you provide the number, hours, and wage rates of student employees under the current Operator?

A: The Operator does not have student employees currently. The contract stipulates that any student employees would be paid the minimum wage if hired.

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Financial

1. Q: Please confirm the College's fiscal year.

A: The College's fiscal year runs from July 1st–June 30th.

2. Q: Does the current Operator offer any faculty/staff discount?

A: The current Operator does not offer any faculty/staff discount. BCC would welcome such a discount if proposed by bidders.

3. Q: Can BCC share how much in funding has been allocated to the 2nd Floor Café and whether the bond is tax exempt? Are any of the funds earmarked for other locations and if so, is the Selected Operator expected to contribute to these renovations as well?

A: Depending on the scope, concept, and scale of proposed renovations, BCC anticipates accessing up to \$500,000 for this project. The College may also be able to seek additional funding sources to meet mutually agreed upon objectives for this project. The College seeks an active partner who is engaged in re-envisioning the 2nd Floor Café seating area to make it more attractive and functional for students and can develop suggestions for revenue producing upgrades in the servery and kitchen as well. The College does not directly issue bonds for capital projects, which are generally funded by the County of Bergen. County-funded projects are generally vetted for use by legal counsel prior to allocation and use. The bond is tax exempt. The funds are earmarked for use at the Pitkin Educational Center only. Thus, the Selected Operator will have no responsibility to contribute funds towards other foodservice areas unless deemed necessary from a revenue-enhancing perspective.

4. Q: What party will have final approval over the renovations of the 2nd Floor Café?

A: This RFP does not construe any ownership of the facilities upon the Selected Operator; therefore, any and all alterations or renovations to the BCC facilities will be contingent upon the College's prior approval.

5. Q: Is there any capital expense that the Operator will have to absorb?

A: There is no existing unamortized investment the incoming Operator will have to absorb.

6. Q: Are utilities provided by BCC or will the Selected Operator have to pay for them?

A: Please refer to Sections 4.14-4.16 in the RFP.

Café Operations

1. Q: What company currently executes café operations? When will its contract expire?

A: Gourmet Dining and Canteen are the current Operators of BCC's café and vending operations. The contracts expire December 31, 2022.

2. Q: Can you provide more details on the inclusion of the culinary program in daily operations? Is there a concept in mind? Where would the revenue flow?

A: The inclusion of the culinary program in the daily operations is aspirational and very much a work in progress. For the purposes of your proposal, please share with us any examples of clients where you have included some integration of the culinary program into operations and suggest options you believe might work at BCC. We do not expect any inclusion to take effect until the Fall of 2023 (or at a time that is mutually agreeable to both parties), and the College anticipates working with the selected Operator to identify options that work for both parties.

3. Q: Should commuter meal plan sales be built into the financial projections separately or should they be shown as additional cash/CC sales?

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A: Please build out your projected meal plan sales separately from cash/CC sales. BCC would like to evaluate what bidders think the potential is for a commuter meal plan program based on experiences at other higher-ed institutions where such programs have been implemented.

4. Q: Have any campus surveys been conducted that shed light on other franchises the BCC community might be partial to?

A: No, BCC has not conducted any formal surveys soliciting the community's thoughts on additional franchises. Bidders should propose franchise and/or non-franchise concepts that they believe would be a good fit for BCC based on the information provided in the RFP.

5. Q: Does BCC have any mobile foodservice offerings such as food trucks at its various locations?

A: No, BCC's current Operator does not utilize food trucks or other mobile foodservice offerings. Bidders are encouraged to elaborate on a potential food truck program in their RFP response if they believe it to be a revenue-enhancing aspect of a future dining program at BCC.

Catering Operations

1. Q: Can you provide a priced catering menu used by the current Operator?

A: Please refer to "BCC Catering Menus" distributed along with this document.

2. Q: Does the current Operator provide any in-kind catering donations?

A: The current Operator was contractually required to provide modest annual in-kind catering donations. However, this requirement is no longer relevant. The Operator may provide in-kind catering on an ad-hoc and informal basis from time to time. In lieu of in-kind catering, the current Operator is required to contribute \$5,000 to be put towards student scholarships if annual sales should exceed \$1,000,000.

3. Q: Is there an online ordering platform for catering? If there is, what system is used and who owns it?

A: The current Operator utilizes and owns an E-Cater online platform. If a transition were to occur, the incoming Operator would need to implement its own online catering order platform.

Vending Operations

1. Q: What company currently executes vending operations at BCC? When will its contract expire?

A: See question 1 from Café Operations above.

2. Q: Does Canteen operate any micro-markets at BCC? Does BCC plan to add additional micro-markets or C-Stores?

A: Canteen operates the C-Store at BCC's Lyndhurst location, as well as various traditional vending machines at BCC's Paramus and Hackensack locations. Please refer to Exhibit B of the RFP for a list of the current Operator's vending assets/locations. BCC does not have any plans for additional micro-markets or c-stores.

3. Q: Is there a security camera monitor at the Lyndhurst C-Store? Can an Operator install and operate monitor(s) as a theft deterrent?

A: Yes, there is a security camera and monitor located at the Lyndhurst C-Store. The Selected Operator can work with BCC to install security cameras and monitors in the C-Store if need be.

4. Q: Is BCC open to the installation of additional vending machines in high-traffic areas?

A: Yes, BCC is open to the installation of additional vending machines if its selected Operator deems it necessary. BCC reserves the right to approve the location of all vending machines across its various locations.

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5. Q: Do you have an exclusive pouring rights/snack products agreement? If so, with what company?

A: Yes, the current Operator has an exclusive pouring rights and snack products agreement with Pepsi at BCC locations. However, this agreement is held by the current Operator and would not be required of a Selected Operator should a transition occur. Any Coke products at BCC locations were most likely alternative products sourced as a result of supply chain shortages.

6. Q: Can you provide a breakdown of sales by machine, commission rates, and the amount of commissions paid to BCC?

A: BCC is unable to share this information. Please refer to Section 2.7 of the RFP for information pertaining to historical vending sales.

7. Q: Does BCC have a student card for cashless purchases at vending machines?

A: No, BCC does not distribute student cards for cashless purchases at vending machines.

8. Q: Is there a transaction fee charge to consumers when paying with credit/debit cards?

A: There is a small transaction fee that is charged to consumers when paying with credit/debit cards. The transaction fee is confidential and negotiated between the Operator and its merchant of record. Thus, we are unable to share the exact amount with bidders.

9. Q: Is any preference given to WMBE and/or disadvantaged vendors?

A: BCC looks to work with WMBEs and/or disadvantage vendors whenever possible. While inclusion of these vendors would certainly be viewed favorably if incorporated into the vending program, BCC believes there will be larger impact resulting from the robust inclusion of WMBEs and/or disadvantaged vendors in the 1st and 2nd Floor Café programs. BCC leaves it up to individual bidders to best determine their procurement strategy.

10. Q: Will the Operator be responsible for stocking of all vending machines at BCC's various locations? What is the earliest time Operator staff can have access to the BCC buildings?

A: Yes, the Operator will be responsible for stocking all vending machines as needed. Operator staff will be able to access BCC's facilities starting at 6:00am. However, Operator staff will be unable to access the Hackensack or Lyndhurst locations on weekends as both are currently closed.
